How do I use the sack?

- Put your household waste into rubbish sacks and tie them up as normal.
- Place your bagged rubbish into the seagull proof sack and secure the velcro fastening.
- The sack will hold the equivalent of 3 black bags of rubbish.
- The sack has a tie at the rear so you can attach it to something to prevent it blowing away.
- Do not tie the handles together.
- Loose rubbish in the sack will not be collected.
- Place the sack out by 7am on the day of collection.
- You may wish to put your property name/number on the bag to help identify it after collections.

Only £3.50 per sack

What to expect

 The sack will be left at the collection point, after the black bags are removed from it, for you to take back in and store until your next collection.

What can I put in my sack?

√ Bagged household rubbish only

Sorry, the following items cannot be accepted:

- X Electrical items Take to the nearest Household Waste Recycling Centre
- X Garden waste Compost at home or use a garden waste bin
- X Bulky waste To arrange for a charged collection call 0300 1243 141
- X Business waste Arrange collection through licensed trade waste operator
- X Loose rubbish
- X Materials for your recycling collection
