Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (RTRA 1984) as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994

The County of Cornwall (Various Roads Padstow) (Special Events) (Padstow Carnival) Order 2015

- 1.** The Cornwall Council ("the Council") makes this Order in exercise of its powers under section 16A of the RTRA 1984 and any other enabling powers to prohibit vehicular traffic over an area of the highway being A389 between Place Hill and Green Lane between the Car Park and the junction of New Street New Street for its entire length Broad Street for its entire length Lanadwell Street for its entire length Middle Street for its entire length Duke Street between the junctions of Middle Street and Market Place Market Place between the junctions of Duke Street and South Quay South Quay for its entire length Riverside for its entire length Station Road between the junction of Riverside and Old Station House as highlighted black on the plan attached to this Order
- 2.** A temporary no waiting restriction be imposed on Duke Street between grid references SW 91804 75446 and SW 91781 75453 affecting both sides of the road for approximately 28m Middle Street for its entire length affecting both sides of the road for approximately 68m Market Place between the junction of Duke Street and grid reference SW9186375417 affecting both side of the road for approximately 16mbetween 17:30 and 20:30 hours
- 3.** The Order is made to facilitate the holding of the following relevant event Padstow Carnival (the event) to take place
- 4.** The Order shall come into operation at 17:30 on 1st August 2015 and will remain in force until 20:30 on 1st August 2015.
- 5.** While the Order is in operation, traffic, including bicycle movement along the highway specified in paragraph 1, will be temporarily restricted between 17:30 to 20:30 hours.
- 6.** All restrictions will be signed and staffed and will remain in force only for as long as is necessary.
- 7.** Nothing in the Order will apply to:
 - Anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a police officer.
 - Any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
 - Traffic associated with the event.

8. Pedestrian access to properties adjoining the highway specified in paragraph 1 will not be affected by the Order
