REMINDER, as you'll recall

- Local groups and organisations contacted using Survey, seeking their views.
- Outcome of which has shown:
 - ✓ Majority want there to be a change to the facilities,
 - ✓ More for 8 – 12 year olds,
 - ✓ Incorporating a skate facility
 - ✓ Multi sports facility at Lawns Tennis court
 - ✓ More seating in play area

In total **£83,388** set aside [£1,088 raised locally for a skatepark via Mayors Charity and remainder being Council's Earmarked Reserve – merged to Recreation Facilities EMR]

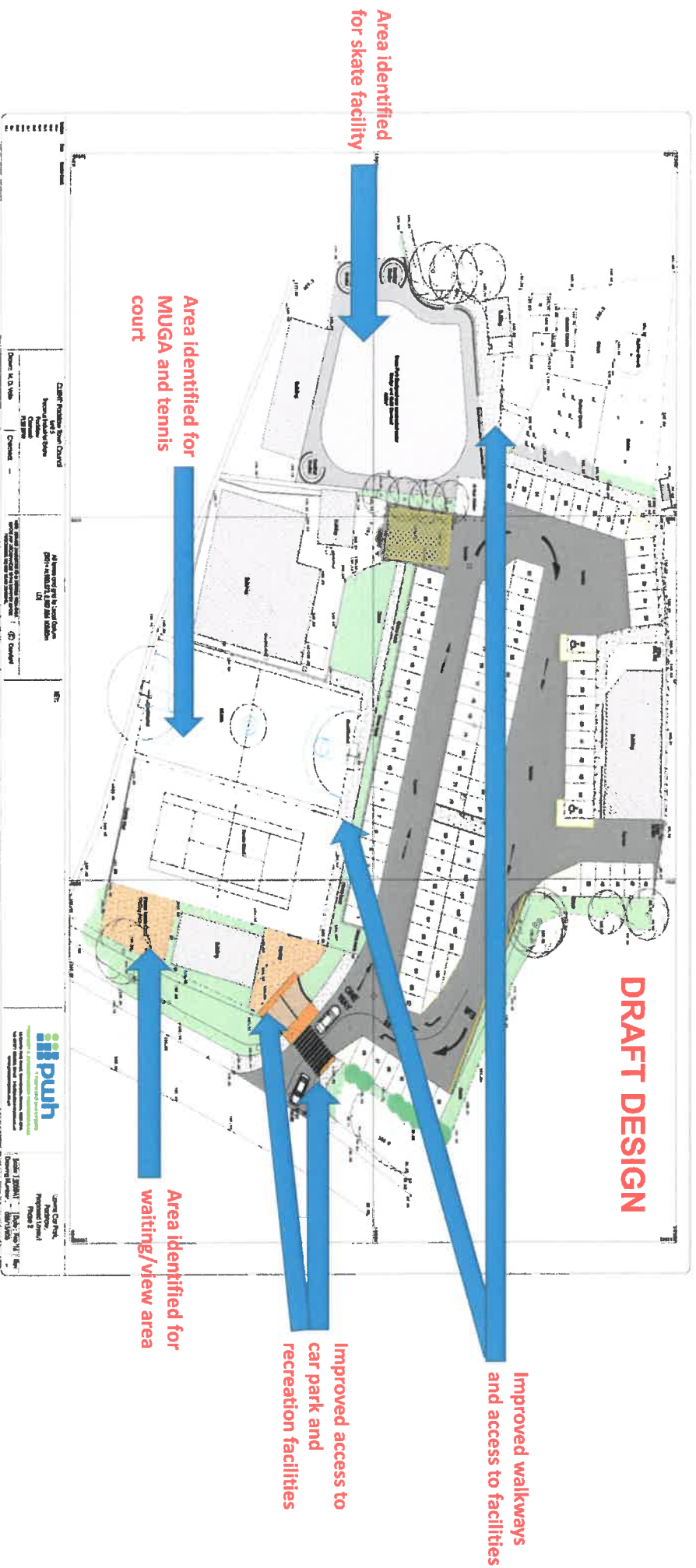

WHAT HAS BEEN HAPPENING?

- Council has been looking at how it can provide better recreation facilities for all the community, hopefully incorporating skate facilities
- Area identified for these improvements is the Lawns
- Council working with PWH Surveyors in taking this forward

WHAT HAS BEEN HAPPENING?

- The project has **GROWN** and Council keen to explore all options to ensure it gets this right!
- Council do not wish to compromise the scheme. PWH considered it not possible to do both MUGA (Multi-Use Games Area) and skatepark together – one will need to be taken forward first
- Other to be incorporated into scheme to improve the area and car park
- PWH has been instructed to advise on best way to take this project forward

- MUGA – more thought to be given on this as to what facilities to provide
