Good afternoon,

I have been asked to provide some crime figures and report for Padstow for the forthcoming Council meeting.

Good News, T/Insp Regie Butler-Card has been promoted, in post, to substantive Inspector and will remain at Bodmin as the Sector Inspector for the Bodmin and Wadebridge area. This covers Padstow and its surrounding communities.

Another piece of good news is that we have been joined by PCSO Jenny Michell. Jenny is an experienced PCSO, who I initially mentored a number of years ago, in Newquay. Jenny has spent a few years away from being an operational officer and has worked alongside the Senior Management Team as the representative of the staff associations. Jenny has returned to operational Policing and will be a regular sight in Padstow. I have already been in Padstow with her, and introduced her to various people, including the Harbour Master, Bryn.

Please see below for a 2019 / 2020 comparison in crimes. As you can see there has been a 41% reduction in reported crime for the same period in 2019, which is quite considerable.
