AGENDA ITEM 9iii: CORRESPONDENCE – LAND USE REQUESTS ON COUNCIL LAND

a) Nadelik Lowen Community Tree of Lights

Nadelik Lowen Committee have been in touch to request that the Community Tree of Lights is placed on the bandstand from week commencing 22 of November 2021 (aiming at erection 25 November) until week commencing 3rd January 2022 (with removal aimed the 5 Jan)

The Committee Secretary passed on thanks for allowing the tree for 2020 and for Council's continued support, updating that they had over 80 messages of remembrance and dedications from the people of Padstow which helped to raise £1,180 for the town lights.

As Council will recall there was an item on February 2020 agenda about bandstand use and it was RESOLVED to approve the requests for use of the bandstand in December being i) Nadelik Lowen to place a Community Tree of Lights in the right hand third of the bandstand for the period 26 November 2020 – 4 January 2021 and; ii) Padstow Christmas Festival to use the left hand two thirds of the bandstand for the purpose of music during the period 3 – 6 December 2020 and to include set up and set down either side of those dates, further that permission for both parties be subject to receiving suitable risk assessments and public liability insurances.

Nadelik Lowen are unsure what other plans they can make for this year event due to COVID19. Anything further would require further permission however, for now they wished to request the Community Tree of Lights to be considered. It's considered this won't be an issue as it is purely a Christmas Tree for display. Currently Council have not received a request from Padstow Christmas Festival Committee at this time.

Are Council happy to grant this request, subject to risk assessments/PLI.
