1. Overview:

1.1 The survey opened on the 2 March 2020 and was open for a period of just over 6 weeks. A total of 41 responses were received, most of which (31) were submitted on 8 March.

2. Promotion:

2.1 The following promotion took place in March prior to lockdown:

- i) Online promotion via Council's social media and website and the Padstow Community Notice Board (Facebook group)
- ii) Posters, leaflets and hard copy questionnaires distributed around the town:

2.2 In addition, leaflets were sent to all Councillors for distribution and promotion and the Receptionist was liaising with Councillors about them attending local groups to promote the survey, however these activities were impeded by the national lockdown on 23 March.

2.3 The continued promotion which would normally take place during the timespan of a consultation was impacted by COVID and in particular the lockdown and associated knock on affects.

3. Responses:

3.1 Appendix 1 sets out a summary of responses. Those who have responded appear to have engaged well with the survey with a number of detailed responses given to the open questions.

4. Funding:

4.1 Its worth reminding Committee that for 2021/22 there is a budget of £5,000 to progress working up proposals for a MUGA. Once Committee have an idea of what they would like to pursue we can then engage the services of Shaun Watts to move this forward and help scope out a plan and how the development can be achieved.

4.2 The Council agreed its Business Plan which outlined for 2022/23 the MUGA project, which will form part of the budget considerations later this year.

4.3 In terms of the Core Building a budget of £8,000 is included in 2021/22 for Core Building running and refurbishment costs.

5. Way Forward

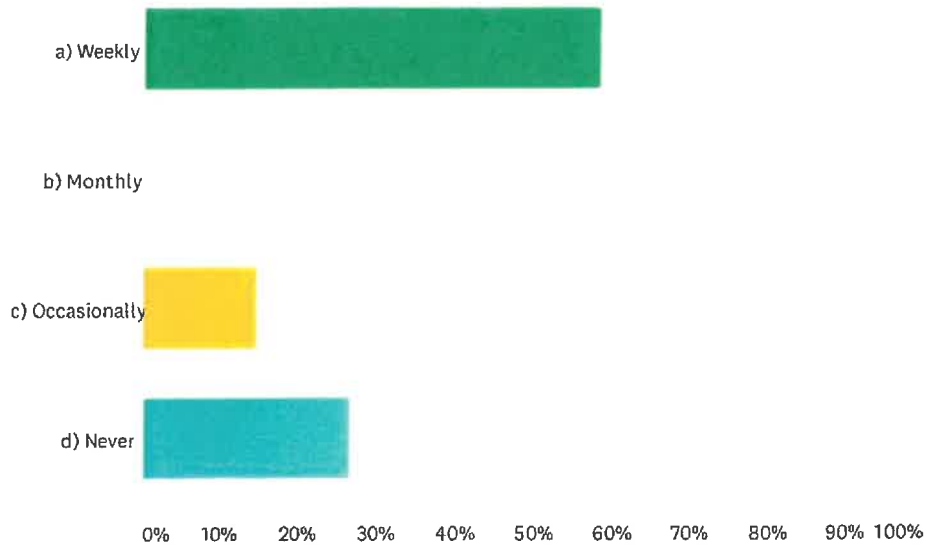
5.1 Following a Councillor request this meeting was arranged to discuss progression of the MUGA, it is worth noting that the consultation also provides responses to the Core Building.

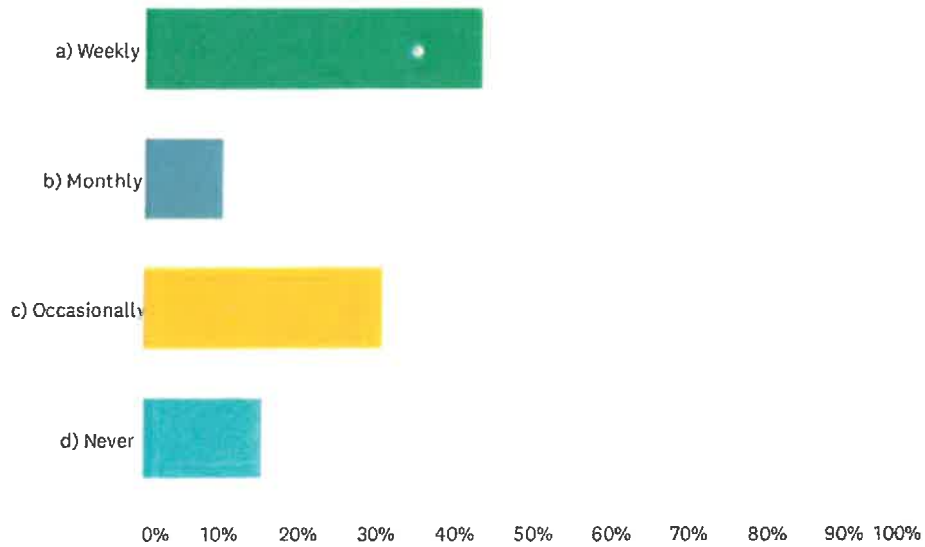

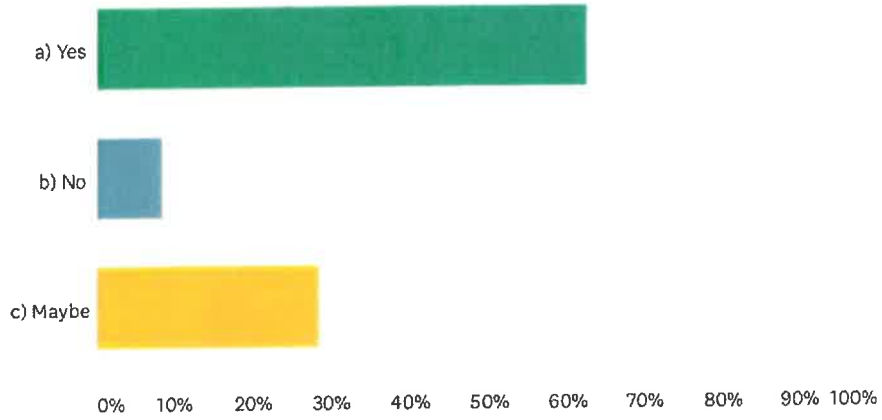

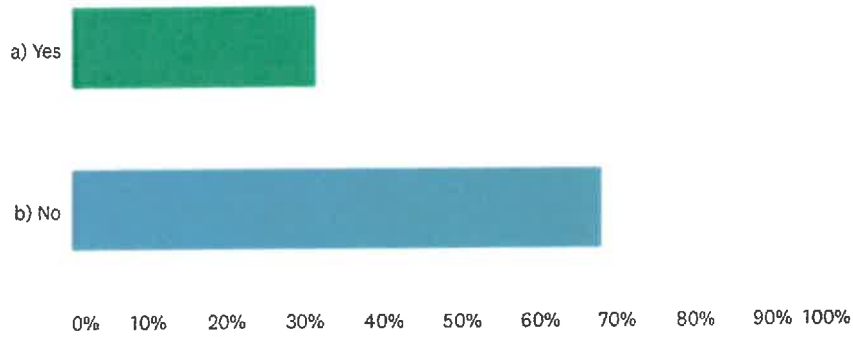

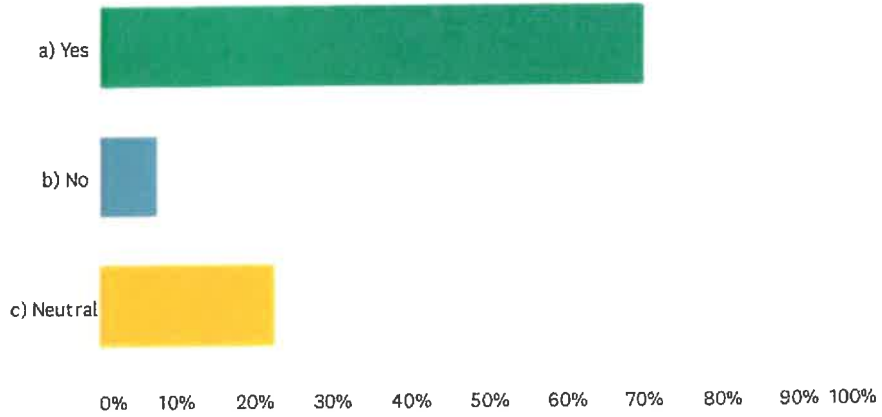

Q13 Do you think floodlighting should be included in the project, if possible, to encourage year-round use of the MUGA?

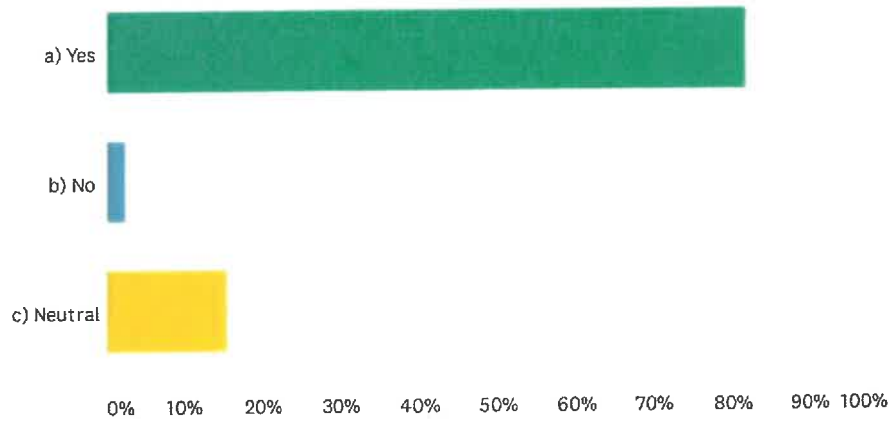

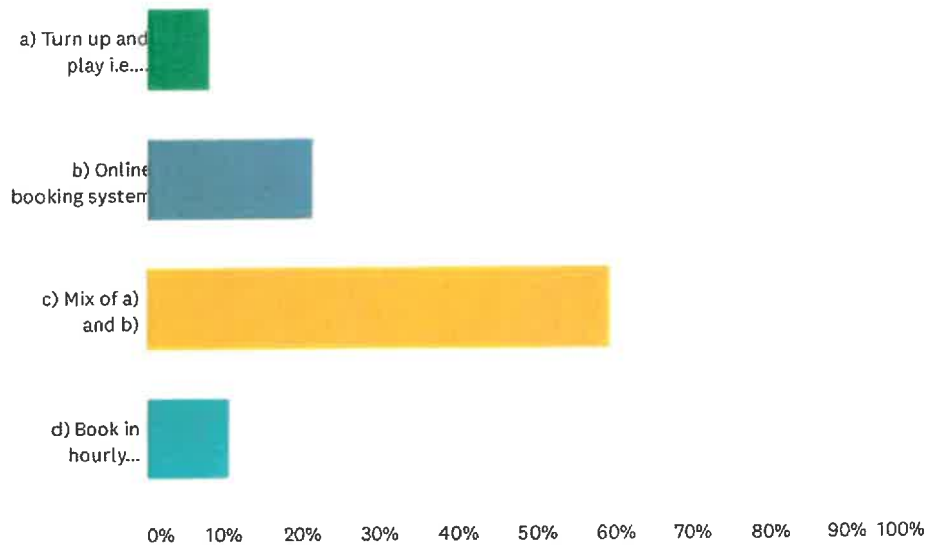

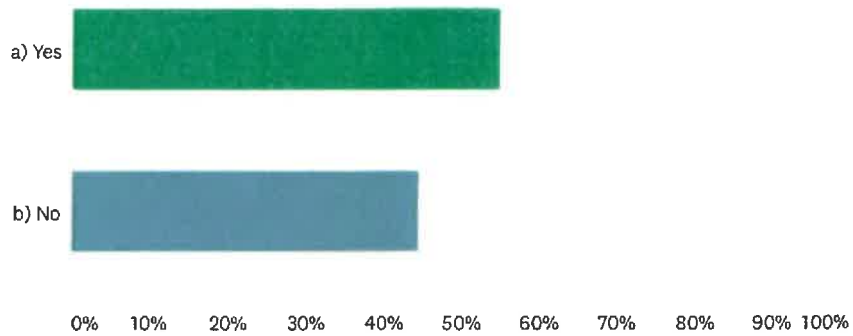
