Next Steps

Following the consultation, the plan and representations will be independently examined. You can request (via email) to be notified of Cornwall Council's decision as an outcome of the examination. If the examiner believes that the NDP meets all of its requirements, a referendum will take place which requires a majority 'yes' vote for the NDP to be made and used by Cornwall Council to determine planning applications within Padstow Parish.

How we use your information

The data is collected by Cornwall Council as the data controller in accordance with the data protection principles contained within the Data Protection Act 1998. The information you provide will be used for the preparation of the Neighbourhood Plan and associated planning policy guidance documents. Full comments, including addresses will also be available to view by any interested party upon request. Regulation 17 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 requires all representations received by Cornwall Council to be submitted to the Examiner. All personal information collected by Cornwall Council is held safely in a secure environment and will be kept in accordance with our retention policy.
