

# Bodmin & Wadebridge Neighbourhood Policing Teams

April 2022

On **TUESDAY 29th MARCH 2022** a **Misuse of Drugs Act** warrant was completed at an address in the Wadebridge area. Officers located a significant amount of suspected 'Class A & B' drugs along with a large quantity of prohibited and offensive weapons including multiple machetes, axes, and a knuckleduster. This is an excellent result with these items now taken out of circulation. Two individuals were arrested, and enquiries are ongoing including the submission of various items for testing / examination.

Staff from Bodmin & Wadebridge along with officers from the Force Support Group and a dog handler were involved in completing the warrant and this has come about following excellent partnership working. We will continue to pursue all available opportunities to target the possession and supply of illegal drugs and the harmful effects this has on our community. With that in mind, we are very keen to hear from anyone that has any intelligence in relation to these issues.

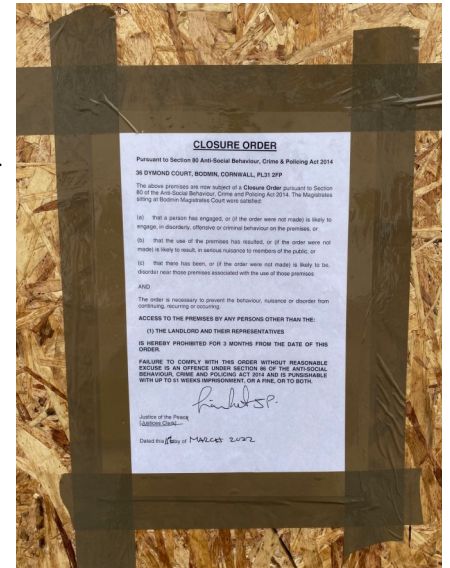
**On Tuesday 15th March 2022 Devon and Cornwall Police and Cornwall Council's Anti-Social Behaviour Team have been granted a Closure Order at a property in Bodmin** closing the property for 3 months meaning it will be a criminal offence for anyone, other than the owners Sanctuary Housing, to enter the property during this period.

Devon and Cornwall Police, working in partnership with the Police Force Legal Team, Cornwall Council's Anti-Social Behaviour Team & Sanctuary Housing applied for the order after the tenant repeatedly ignored advice & warnings including a Partial Closure Order to maintain his tenancy. The



tenant continued to allow anti-social behaviour causing ongoing nuisance and disorder. This Order will come as welcome news to many local residents who have been victims of continual anti-social behaviour and nuisance arising from this property.

Inspector BUTLER-CARD from Bodmin police Station said "This is a fantastic result and sends a clear message that anti-social behaviour will not be tolerated and together with our partners we will continue to use all legal remedies to protect our communities. If you are experiencing anti-social behaviour where you live, please get in touch with us".

**Local neighbourhood Beat Manager PC Alex Allen has been delivering interoperability awareness sessions, as part of our Key Partners RNLI Lifeguards seasonal induction programme .**

PC Allen stated, “ The Wadebridge Policing Sector covers a vast area of coastline from Port Isaac to Bedruthan Steps, which in the summer months sees thousands of beach users, with both visitors and locals alike enjoying our fantastic beaches.

With the increased summer demand over recent years due to staycation trend of the pandemic, there has never been a better time to ensure local Police have excellent working relationships with our key stakeholders, such as the RNLI.

The RNLI Lifeguard service are essential in keeping our communities safe and these interoperability sessions aim to equip lifeguards with an awareness of incidents which are likely to involve police attention. For example, missing persons and beach related crime and anti social behaviour”.

**#MeetYourPolice | A tasty bit of alphabet soup for you today: Do you know your ARV from your TFU?**

An Armed Response Vehicle (ARV) is the term which generally used to define a patrolling vehicle which contains firearms and less lethal options. The day-to-day role of ARV officers is primarily to attend and deal with firearms incidents. They also support the roads policing team and response teams. That means they’re equipped to deal with almost any incident, anywhere in the Force area and sometimes beyond. The Tactical Firearms Unit (TFU) on the other hand support ongoing incidents (rather than being the first response to spontaneous ones) and help with pre-planned firearms operations.

**#MeetYourPolice | We've got a lot of coastline and waterways in Devon and Cornwall so part of our Force Support Group – or FSG – is the dive team.**

Diving tasks include recovering cars, weapons, stolen property, and searching for missing people.

Their work isn't just confined to open water either. Police divers can also search confined spaces such as sewers and holes underground. Probably not a great job if you're claustrophobic.

These less lethal weapons are also known as conducted energy devices

(CED). All officers who are trained to use them must meet the nationally approved standard set down and approved by the Home Office and College of Policing.

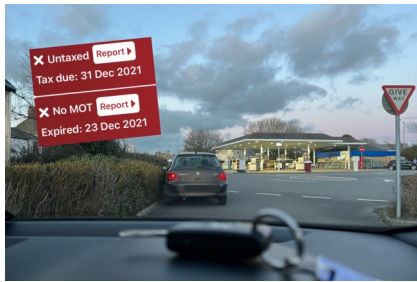

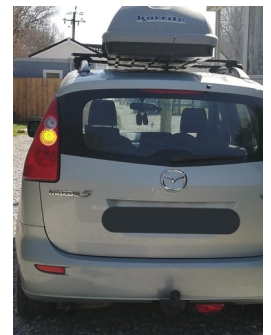

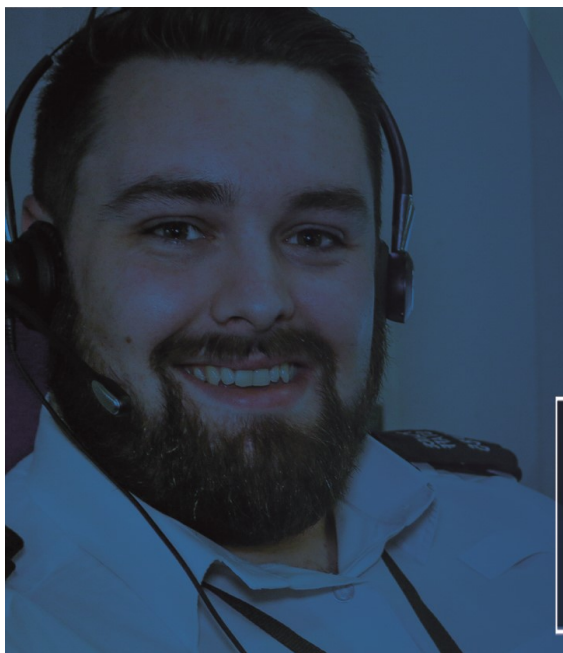
# Devon and Cornwall **ALERT**
